



• Financially sustainable

- Paid-for services for self-funding sector and early adopters
- Start with home energy assessments
 - Gradually expanding the range of services over time
- Include a special focus on listed and historic homes
 - Reflecting the additional needs of some of our local housing
- Learn from behavioral science and community based social marketing
 - To enhance impact and support lasting change
- Testing a model
 - That can be replicated by other community energy groups

Retrofit Coordination

- Project Management through the whole retrofit process

- Energy Redress Scheme £156k
- Local Energy Advice Demonstrator 'Green Heritage Homes' Project – £344k

- New pre-application process to be piloted








Hottest June on record

Daily average sea surface temperature between 60° North and 60° South, 1979-2023
















When's the launch?


